Council, the Community School Program will be undergoing a number of changes this year. These changes are based on the overall feeling that the program's first priority is not day care but the provision of a stimulating and varied activities program for all interested children and their families in our neighborhood.

Towards this end, we have developed the following guidelines for this year's program:

THE AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM WILL BE BROKEN INTO TWO PROGRAMS: A K-3rd ACTIVITIES PROGRAM IN THE AGASSIZ SCHOOL, AND A PROGRAM OF SPECIAL COURSES AND ACTIVITIES FOR 4th-6th GRADERS IN THE SANCTUARY BUILDING.

I. The K-3rd Program:

1. will admit 60 children per afternoon, on a pre-registered basis.
2. Children will be limited to 3 afternoons a week until the 60 spaces are filled.
3. Families must register their children for 1, 2 or 3 specific afternoons per week during registration week (Sept. 5-9).
4. Registration will take place in the library from 2:30-5:00 each afternoon that week.

5. The program begins on Monday, September 12th, and runs from 2:30 to 5:00 every afternoon.
6. The daily program will include: $\frac{1}{2}$ hour for snack, one hour of special projects or activities, and one hour of free choice activities. Some of the special activities will include: gymnastics, science, cooking, photography, etc. Some of these will be scheduled by the time registration begins, but unfortunately some will have to wait until we find work-study students to teach them.
7. The cost of the program is \$30.00 for 3 afternoons, \$20.00 for 2, and \$10.00 for 1, paid per term at the beginning of each term. Some scholarship help will be available so feel free to ask about it.
8. We will have two full-time assistants this year: Smiley Winter (one of the directors of Nortons Woods this past summer) and Diane Williams (who worked on our Science Van in 1974). We also hope to have a C.E.T.A. worker to fill out our staff, plus work-study students when they become available.

4th-6th Graders' Program

Tentatively we have scheduled classes in: beading, gymnastics, carpentry, and photography and we will be soliciting more ideas from the kids themselves in September.

2. The program will begin in October. Registration week will be Sept. 26-30, at Sanctuary (where the courses will be held).
3. Fees will be charged for each course. Courses will be of differing lengths and will cost differing amounts.
4. Gym hockey times will be scheduled during the week (predominantly evenings) and will be free.

The EVENING PROGRAM will begin in October and will include: gym. hockey, teen basketball, dance, guitar lessons, rehearsals of the Little Orchestra, and possibly women's self-defense, folk dancing for families, and adult volleyball.

Please let us know which of these activities interest you and feel free to suggest others as well. We will list all the evening activities in the October Whistler.
