Responsibilities

- Supports day to day programming for a mixed-age (2.9-5 years) preschool classroom of up to 20 children. In addition to program activities, this includes:
 - Helping with toileting, preparing and serving snack, supervising outdoor play, setting up and facilitating activities, maintaining program materials and space
- Works with lead teacher to implement curriculum
- Supports lead teacher in family communication
 - sensitive communication understood to be handled by lead teacher

- Any other duties to support preschool program
