Position:

Agassiz Baldwin Community is seeking a Dance and Drama Teacher for a vibrant, creativity focused community-based children's program. During the school year, the Dance and Drama Teacher will lead classes focused on either Dance or Drama for all of our age groups: Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grade, and 3rd-5th grade. During the summer, we support children throughout the entire day in mixed age group settings. Our program is choice based: children select the activities they want to try and join the class for 1 hour each time. Performing arts groups work together to create or focus on a piece to perform for families. The focus is on teamwork and creativity, trying new things and challenging oneself. Our teaching team is creative, energetic and collaborative. We work hard, have fun, are flexible, and have a passion for providing enriching activities for children. Agassiz Baldwin Afterschool teachers come from all backgrounds and interests and we welcome a diverse pool of applicants!

Job requirements:

- Experienced teacher with minimum of two years experience teaching children ages 4-11.
- Strong background in Dance and Drama.
- Ability to engage a group size of 10-13 children and share your passion for all things dance and drama.
- Interest in providing instruction in culturally diverse genres of music, dance, games, and performance pieces.
- Must have the ability to exercise good judgment and safely supervise children.
- Resolve disciplinary problems appropriately and complete injury reports as needed.
- Walk children safely between locations and oversee transitions.

Schedule:

The schedule is 20 hours/week. Summer shifts fall during program hours—between 8:30 am and 6:00 pm. During the school year, our afterschool teaching hours are from 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm Monday-Friday. Must commit to working through the end the school year.

Pay: Depends on experience, up to \$20/hour
