Lifeguard for Summer Program Beach Trips

Outback Summer Program seeks a responsible, energetic and experienced lifeguard to accompany the program for beach field trips. Outback will have two lifeguards who will assist in supervising 110 children on the oceanfront. We visit the areas most beautiful beaches, including Singing Beach, Stage Fort Park and Crane Beach. We welcome a diverse pool of applicants!

Schedule:

- Outback beach trips take place each Thursday, between July 11th and August 26th. A full eight-week commitment is required.
- Beach trip hours are Thursdays, 7:30am-3:15pm.

Candidates must:

- Be 18-years or older.
- Hold current and up to date certifications in CPR, First Aid, and Lifeguard Training. Certifications must be valid through August 31, 2019.
- 2 years experience life guarding for school-age children *preferred*
- Have a record of excellence in safety and responsibility, great energy and a positive attitude.
