PRENTISS STREET SEWER AND STORM DRAIN INSTALLATION

On Monday, June 28 (weather permitting), crews will begin sewer and drain installation work on Prentiss St between Oxford St and Frost St. During this phase of the construction, Prentiss St will be closed to through traffic, but open to abutters. Residents will be allowed to use Frost St to access Prentiss St. Frost St will become a two-way street for the project duration.

Project Schedule

- This phase of construction is expected to last 2-3 weeks.
- Work hours are 7 AM to 4 PM, Monday through Friday (Crews will not work on Monday, July 5 in observance of Independence Day).

Traffic Plan during Construction

- During this work, Prentiss St will be closed to through traffic from Oxford St to Frost St. Frost St will become a two-way street.
- Abutters and emergency vehicles will have access at all times.
- All city services will continue.

What to Expect during Construction

- This is noisy, dirty work. You will hear banging and vehicle back-up alarms. Jackhammers, Dump Trucks, and Backhoes will be used.
- “No Parking” signs will be posted; please be sure to check dates/times. Traffic signs and police details will be in place to assist neighbors.
- Pedestrian access and access into properties will be maintained at all times, but may be restricted in certain ways.
